



SUPPORTING A SEAMLESS RELOCATION

On Time, With Total Precision

Logistics Management Institute (LMI) needed to relocate its corporate headquarters to a newly constructed facility in McLean, Virginia. The move had to be completed over the Christmas holiday with minimal disruption to operations. With nearly 400 employees, specialized equipment, and construction still in progress at the new site, LMI needed a partner it could count on. That partner was Interstate Logistics.

CHALLENGES

The timeline was tight and the conditions were complex. Construction at the new location was still underway, requiring coordination with contractors on-site. The relocation also involved moving secure materials from LMI's Security Office, which required line-of-sight supervision and cleared personnel. In total, Interstate needed to pack, move, and reconnect over 440 desktop systems. The team had to manage cable routing, monitor mounting, and printer setups while maintaining security and minimizing downtime.



OBJECTIVES

Complete the full relocation of LMI's 216,000-square-foot office to a 165,000-square-foot headquarters. The move included office contents, classified safes, IT systems, and specialized rooms. Everything had to be transferred safely and efficiently within a limited holiday window.



CONCLUSION

Interstate approached the project with flexibility and careful planning. A team of 49 trained and security-approved employees was assigned to handle the move. In addition, 20 IT specialists were brought in to manage the disconnection and reconnection of desktop systems. Over the course of 36 hours, 55 truckloads were successfully relocated. Each stage of the move was managed in sync with LMI's schedule and security requirements.

The team also handled the distribution of excess furniture to LMI's satellite offices across the country. Every task, from packing to final setup, was completed without damage or delays. The entire relocation finished on time, with no punch list items and no interruptions to LMI's operations.

According to LMI's leadership, Interstate did more than move an office. They reduced stress, suggested smart efficiencies, and supported the transition with professionalism and care. What could have been a difficult project became a smooth and successful relocation.
